#### **7. ENTRY FEES**

**7.1** The entry fee is:

a) 1<sup>st</sup> closing date of entries – 150 €

b) 2<sup>nd</sup> closing date of entries – 250 €

All drivers will be informed about the organizers promotion at the administrative checking and must put the labels to the explained position at the race car.

#### **8. INSURANCE**

**8.1** The organiser is insured for any damages cause to other person in terms of this event contract with Powszechny Zakład Ubezpieczeń up to the amount of EUR 50.000,-.

**8.3.** Every driver must present their personal accident insurance policies.

### **IV. CHECKING**

#### **10. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKING**

**10.1** Only drivers must report to administrative checking which will be held at secretariat – Saturday 19.06.2010 08h45– 12h45.

#### **11. SCRUTINEERING**

**11.1** Any car taking part in the Event must be presented by the driver or his official representative to scrutineering, which will be held at the paddock on 19.06.2010 from 09h00 to 13h00.

### **V. RUNNING OF THE EVENT**

#### **13. PRACTICE AND DRIVERS INFORMATION**

**13.1** Free and official timed practice will be obligatory. For the free practice-sessions, the pre-grid will be organised in 3 lanes, one for each division. If there are enough cars in one lane, the start can be given for that group. This procedure must be repeated until the end. In each division, official timed practice sessions will be organised, starting from the highest to the lowest number of the cars, over 3 laps, but only 2 laps will count: after 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> lap, the best time will be taken into account.

The best time of one lap from all official timed practice sessions will determine the starting position for the first Heat. In the event of a tie, the next best lap time of the drivers who have tied will determine the starting position.

Each driver must complete at least one lap in practice. If not, in the first qualifying heat he may be allowed to start at the discretion of the Stewards.

Cars from different divisions will run separately.

The Joker Lap can be used during the free practice sessions, but it is not permitted during timed practice sessions.

**13.2** Information in English and in the host language of the Event will be given to the drivers in writing to all drivers.

#### 14. QUALIFYING

There will be 4 laps in the qualifying Heats.

**14.2.1** In each qualifying heat, one of the laps must be the Joker Lap. Those drivers who did not take his Joker Lap will receive a time penalty of 30 seconds. For a second infringement in the same heat, will be decided by the Stewards. Two judges of fact will be appointed to note the numbers of the cars passing through.

At the exit of the Joker Lap, the cars on the main track have priority.

#### 15. FINALS

There will be 6 laps in the Finals.

In each Final, one of the laps must be the Joker Lap. Those drivers who did not take this Joker Lap or take it more than once will be classified last in that Final before the non-starters. In case this concern more than one driver, they will be classified in the order of their respective positions on the starting grid before the non-starters.

At the exit of the Joker Lap, the cars on the main track have priority.

##### 20. PROTESTS – APPEALS

**20.1** All protests will be lodged in accordance with the International Sporting Code.

All protests must be made in writing and handed to the Clerk of the Course or his assistant, or in their absence any of the stewards of the meeting, together with the sum of 1200 PLN (300 €) . If the protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of different parts of a car, the claimant must make a deposit up to 3000 PLN (1000 €).

**20.5** Competitors have the right to appeal, as laid down in Article 181, 182 and 183 of the Code and also as set out in the rules of International Court of Appeal.

The amount of the appeal fee is 3000 PLN (1000 €).

##### 22. FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

Each driver is responsible for ensuring that a fire extinguisher is available within his own team's area inside the paddock.

##### 23. ENVIRONMENTAL POLLUTION

Each Driver is requested to ensure that a plastic sheet (minimum dimensions 4 metres by 5) is spread on the ground in the place reserved for his team where work is to be done on his car, in order to prevent any pollution in case of an accidental leak, etc.

##### 24. DRIVERS' LIAISON OFFICER

The Drivers' Liaison Officer will present a schedule of their duties, which shall be posted on the official notice board of the event.
