

Latvian dragrace festival 2024

COMPETITION RULES

1. Introduction
2. Latvian drag racing competitions are held in accordance with the Latvian Automobile Federation (further LAF) National sport codex, LAF Drift regulatory documents of the commission, to the regulations of the Latvian Drag Race Cup 2024 and their appendices, and these Drag Race Competition Regulations. Changes and additions to these Regulations are announced only in dated additions to the Regulations approved by the Organizer or the Commissioner.

4. The qualifying stage of the Baltic Cup is held based on the regulations of the Baltic Cup Commission, which you can find here: <https://balticdragracing.eu/rules/>
5. Sports cars must comply with the technical regulations of the respective class, the Latvian Drag Race Cup 2024 regulations and the Latvian Drag Race Cup 2024 technical regulations: (<https://laf.lv/sports/drifta-un-dragreisa-komisija/dragreiss/nolikumi/>)
6. All drivers, applicants, organizers and official persons, each in their own name, and their subordinate employees, all who are involved in the competition, respect and obey the LAF National Sports Codex (hereinafter - the Codex), these regulations (hereinafter - the Regulations) and subordinate documents .
7. Moto drag race training and Baltic Cup moto qualifying information will be published soon.
8. The Regulation is published in Latvian. In cases of disputes arising from editorial translations and interpretations, the decisive language is Latvian.
9. All persons who are in any form in the territory of the motorsport event or participate in the competition:
10. Do so at your own risk and are aware that motor sports are dangerous and involve significant risks that may result in consequences such as injury, health damage, disability and death, as well as property damage or other losses.
11. Understands that LAF, the organizer and race officials are not responsible for any injuries or damages that occur during the race (or other motorsport event).
12. Competition time: AUGUST 3-4, 2024.
13. Place of the Competition: Latvia, Ventspils Airport territory.
14. Distance: quarter mile (402.336 meters).
15. Competition format of the festival: in accordance with clause 9.2.8 of the "2024 LATVIA DRAGRAY CUP REGULATIONS".(<https://www.fia.com/regulation/category/101>)
16. Daily plan: according to the attachment Nr.1
17. Organizers of the competition: Association "Joma Racing Team" Ādažu district, Ādažu parish, Stapriņi, Inču street 47, LV-2164 Reg.Nr. 40008264707
18. Competition officials can only have a valid judging license issued by LAF at the event.

25. Competition Participants
26. Any natural person can become a participant in the competition who has a car that meets the technical requirements of the regulations and who has obtained an annual or one-time drag racing license from the LAF Drift Commission, as well as a valid ASN drag racing license recognized by the FIA of any other country. The participant must have a valid LAF-approved life insurance policy starting at EUR 1,500.
27. Licenses and insurance can be purchased at www.laflicences.lv or on site on the day of the event.
28. Responsibility of participants
29. Each Participant and car owner is responsible for the technical condition of the car and the actions taken during the competition and their consequences.
30. By filling out the Participant's card, the Participant confirms with his signature that he has familiarized himself with and undertakes to comply with the given competition regulations, technical requirements, the instructions of the officials responsible for the competition and their subordinates. He is also aware that he is responsible for the employees of his technical and service park and the persons who accompany him. Takes responsibility for the technical condition of the car and is aware of the need to observe order, cleanliness and generally accepted ethical norms.
31. All Participants must use the competition area in the Participant Park and place their car on a service carpet with a size of at least 6x3 m (six by three meters), or use a carpet on which the outer edges of the sports car are at least 50 cm outside the car body. In case of non-compliance with the rule, a fine of EUR 50.00 is provided. Each box must have a fire extinguisher - with a minimum volume of 4 kg and marked ABC, type - powder, if the fire extinguisher is not placed, a fine of EUR 50.00.
32. The use of open flames and grills in the competition area is strictly prohibited for the Participants of the competition. Fine – EUR 100.00.
33. Staying overnight in the competition area is prohibited.
34. It is forbidden to make mechanical damage in the entire area of the event (strengthen canopies, tents, etc.), it is not allowed to press the wheels of the lifts on the asphalt. In case of non-compliance with the rules, the fine is EUR 1000.00.
35. "Burnout" i.e. heating of tires is allowed only in a designated place. Tire heating outside the designated area, fine – EUR 200.00.
36. Starting order
37. The number of participants in each class is unlimited. The organizer of the competition and the chief judge on the day of the competition can decide to limit, reduce or increase the number of Participants, as well as to combine classes if there are less than 3 Participants in one of them.
38. The starting position is electronically controlled by the wheels of the front axle of the car.
39. The Participant must arrive at the start within 5 (five) minutes of the invitation issued by the judge responsible for the start. If, after the invitation, 5 (five) minutes have passed and the Participant has not arrived in the starting area before the start, then the Participant is awarded a loss for this race. The invitation

may be given to the Participant personally or by microphone using the competition playback equipment.

40. In the distance, the Participant may ride only on the selected track. The Participant with a better qualification result has the preference to choose a track in a pair - it is mentioned first in the start list.
41. After crossing the finish line, the driver must reduce the driving speed in a straight line. Before performing any turning manoeuvres, it is imperative to ensure that an emergency situation will not be created.
42. Results and awarding
43. At the Latvian drag racing festival 2024, the three best drivers of each class are awarded.
44. Awarding takes place on the territory of the track in the starting area, after the approval of the chief judge.
45. In case of Force Majeure, if only qualifying races have taken place and at least one qualifying race has been performed for all Participants registered in the competition stage, then the results are calculated according to the qualifying result.
46. If the event is canceled due to reasons other than the organizer, 85% of the registration fee is returned. If the event is canceled due to unfavorable weather conditions (rain, snow, storm or any other effects of natural conditions), the registration fee is returned in the amount of 50%. If qualifying races have taken place, winners will be determined by qualifying times and entry fees are non-refundable.

6. The participation fee must be paid online until 31.07.2024, (It will also be possible to pay on site on the day of the event. The fees will not change on the day of the event:
7. EUR 70,00 - For Participants of the Lithuanian Championship (price includes participation + 1 mechanic's pass),
8. EUR 35,00 - Participation in an additional class for the participants of the Lithuanian championship.
9. EUR 100,00 - Baltic Cup Participants (Baltic Cup qualifying participants are paying on the spot on the day of the event).
10. EUR 25,00 - Additional mechanic pass.
11. EUR 10,00 - Additional service car (one service car with or without a trailer is included for each rider).
12. ONLINE REGISTRATION IS OPEN TIL 31.07.2024,12:00 O'CLOCK.
